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Entry Checklist & Stages

ENTRY CHECKLIST

- Register your school's interest on Entries Page at www.OceanAcidification.net
- Create your own school art challenge following the Selection Criteria opposite.
- Select the winning piece of artwork and with your student complete the Entry Form. Please remember to also enter the student's own 100 word support submission.
- Submit the artwork, written submission and Entry Form to your nearest participating Regional Gallery before 3 July. Details of participating Regional Galleries are on the Entries Page at www.OceanAcidification.net
- Each Regional Gallery panel will select 5 finalists and dispatch for State Judging. You will be notified in person if your school makes the State Finals.
- The three winners will be announced at Federation Square on 12 August at 6pm.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Please share and use these Selection Criteria when judging your school artwork. These will be the same criteria for the Regional Gallery and State Final Judging.

There are 5 core assessment points with relative values adding up to 50 points.

1. The engaging nature of the work's title (10 points)
2. Clear communication of the impact of Ocean Acidification (10 points)
3. Technical technique used to produce the artwork (10 points)
4. Level of visual appeal of the artwork (10 points)
5. The lasting impression of the artwork (10 points)

Remember to also share the 8-minute curriculum-based video on the website Entries Page with students to ensure they all start with the same level of understanding.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Only one entry is allowed per school.
- By submitting the original artwork the creator agrees to allow it to be used for non-commercial purposes until September 2014. Also for it to be posted and used as an educational resource online.
- All work must be created and judged adhering to the Selection Criteria outlined above.
- Only State Finalists and Art Challenge Winners will be notified of the results. These will also be posted at www.OceanAcidification.net
- At each judging stage the panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- The prize money takes the form of Student Study and School Environmental Grants. The administration and payment of these will be by independent chartered accountants - PKF, Level 14, 140 William Street, Melbourne, Victoria, 3000
- The People's Choice 'Study Trip' will be awarded based on public votes throughout the duration of the exhibition at Federation Square. No school groups visiting the exhibition with a State Finalist on display can vote in this instance. The winning student and school will be notified in person in early September 2013.
